


Mission Ready: MRC GEM Volunteers in Action





As Sherwin Levinson passes the torch after more than eighteen years of dedicated service as Executive Director of MRC GEM, we pause to honor the extraordinary impact he's made. Sherwin restructured our now allvolunteer unit, following his career in business and computer science. His leadership has ranged from establishing the very first Emergency Management plan for the City of Berkeley Lake after the 1998 tornado to coordinating volunteer deployment during the COVID-19 response. Under his guidance, MRC GEM has evolved into a widely recognized team, earned national recognition, and become a trusted partner with Gwinnett, Newton, and Rockdale Public Health.

Beyond his technical expertise, shaped by studies in Physics at MIT and the University of Chicago and an MBA in Math Methods and Computer Science, Sherwin's true gift has been cultivating a culture of collaboration, training, and mutual support. Whether chairing the Gwinnett County Citizens Corps Council, mentoring neighboring units, or inspiring volunteers to attain CERT and GEMA certifications, Sherwin's leadership has strengthened our community's resilience. Together with his wife, Judee, for more than 50 years, Sherwin has modeled the power of partnership, both at home and in service.
