Verbal Judo is a proven communication strategy used to diffuse conflict, encourage cooperation, and maintain control under pressure, skills especially valuable during emergency responses and public events.

Participants left the training with a stronger understanding of how words can be used to build rapport and redirect negative energy into positive outcomes.

Bellefonte Nuclear Power Plant Tour

Last month, thanks to the contacts of one of our members, R. Michael Carter, several MRC GEM members had the adventure of touring the Bellefonte Nuclear Power Plant in Hollywood, Jackson County, Alabama.

This amazing facility was begun in the 1970s, but has remained unfinished and inactive since the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) halted its work there in 1988, when the facility was about 85% complete. Since then, it is maintained by a skeleton staff of eleven devoted employees, including those who gave us a most informative, not to mention physically challenging, tour.

Tours of the facility are rather rare, and are limited to those involved in radiation response. We also learned that there are currently ongoing efforts to revive the facility for use, which could bring thousands of jobs to the area.
